

DRESS CODE REGULATIONS

1. Fire Side Grill – Business, business casual, or Club appropriate attire is preferred. Please wear proper footwear. Not Club appropriate attire for this area is defined as: tank tops, cut-offs, hoodies, concert type t-shirts, swimming attire (other than pool area), athletic wear, pants or shorts worn exceedingly low on hips, soiled or excessively worn clothing.
2. Veranda – In addition to the above regulations, multi pocketed “cargo” shorts and denim shorts are prohibited on the Veranda. After 5:00 PM, Tuesday – Saturday, and all-day Sunday, seasonal business attire for all members, their family members, and guests is preferred in this area. Please wear proper footwear and gentlemen are required to remove all hats when entering the Veranda.
Not Club appropriate attire for this area is defined as: multi-pocketed “cargo” shorts, denim shorts, tank tops, cut-offs, hoodies, concert type t-shirts, swimming attire (other than pool area), athletic wear, pants or shorts worn exceedingly low on hips, soiled or excessively worn clothing.
3. Patio Side Grill – Family preferred dining. Business casual or Club appropriate attire, including athletic leisure. Please wear proper footwear.
Not Club appropriate attire for this area is defined as: backward hats, tank tops, cut-offs, swimming attire (other than pool area), pants or shorts worn exceedingly low on the hips, soiled or excessively worn clothing.
4. Bar – Business, business casual, or Club appropriate attire is preferred. Please wear proper footwear.
Not Club appropriate attire for this area is defined as: backward hats, tank tops, cut-offs, swimming attire (other than pool area), pants or shorts worn exceedingly low on hips, soiled or excessively worn clothing.
5. Manager’s discretion will be used on a “as needed” basis.
